Over the last two years, MDA's Muscle Team has netted more than \$200,000 to fund local clinics, support groups, research and the local MDA Summer Camp for children, ages 6 to 17 years, living with muscular dystrophy.

All of the activities are adjusted so that every camper has the opportunity to participate in swimming, field hockey, cabin life, crafts and the highlight of the week – The Friendship Dance! Recently, B.J. Bohne, President and CEO of Imperial Crane, donated \$8,000 to sponsor a cabin for the 2012 MDA Summer Camp. The cost covers ten children and their one-on-one counselors for the week.
